# What do you need to know?

6

- You need to be happy with what you are doing...it will show. Want to improve your mood? Try singing outloud to songs you love. This can be very helpful. Feel foolish? It's normal and if perfectly normal to do so...enjoy yourself with song!
- Viewers need to see the video so you need a lot of light...or appropriate to your videos needs (dark and creepy for some videos).
- You need to know what your channel is about.
- The audio can be a killer (good thing) or a channel killer (bad thing). Practice with the equalizer on your equipment. You can also get a high quality microphone. Sound is like food for your ears, and you don't want to feed them garbage...right?
- Don't go out and spend a lot of money just to find out you don't want to make videos.

# What do you need to know? Cont.

7

- Copyrights, plagiarism, fair rights, open source, free, fees, your audience, uploading, file formats, and being civilized are all extremely important things to know about.
- Copyrights, plagiarism, and fair rights are all about what you can use legally.
- Fair use is a legal doctrine that permits limited use of copyrighted material without acquiring permission from the rights holders. Learn about this, copyrights, and plagiarism early on. The last thing you need is a lawsuit from Disney or an international lawsuit.
- You don't have to master them all right away but they are important.

# What do you need to know? Cont.

8

- If you don't know what you can use, just use things that you make or record only.
- YouTube is extremely picky about music so copyrighted music will be a constant battle. Music makes videos better, by the way.
- Can't afford it? Open source and free are your best friends here.
- Careful not to waste all of your money getting started because you might never earn anything from YouTube.
- The more you do with it, the more you and your channel can grow.
- All of your channels need at least 4,000 watch hours in the previous 12 months and 1,000 subscribers as of the making of this guide.
- File formats is important. Mp3 (audio), wave (audio), mp4 (video), ogg (audio used by LMMS), avi (video type used in editors but often massive) and many others out there. Knowing these will help.



# What do you need to know? Cont.

9

- Being civilized or not is a big part of being a YouTuber.  
“Can I make videos that are completely vulgar?” Yes.  
Michael “Rage Quit” Jones found his dream job by being a [censor]. “Will I have to worry about being like this?” Yes.  
Logan Paul lost monetization rights and killed his channel because his video.
- He uploaded a video where he found a dead body in suicide forest and killed his channel and reputation. He is turning his life around but he can’t get money from YouTube anymore and his reputation is damaged a lot.
- “Should I be family friendly?”  
That depends on your channel. Do you want to be family friendly?

# Needs

10

- “Do I need everything in this book?” No. Getting everything on here, even for a professional, would be a waste of time and money.
- “What are the basic things that I do need?”
- You need a video so either a phone with camera, a camera, a webcam, or a capturing device. Having all of these would be really good.
- You need a microphone, editing software (without being able to edit, your videos will have to be recorded and uploaded as is), keyboard, mouse, and a plan.

# Needs cont.

- “I want to be a gaming channel.” Well, you’ll need games. “No money... 😞” I’ll make a separate page for that soon. 😊
- Above all...Keep at it. Never give up. Having a YouTube channel can have perks later on, even if it is just to see how you’ve grown.

# More Advice

- “Need Games...I’m Broke.”
- Keeps your eyes open and keep looking for ways to get free, make deals with indie devs, or use what you have.
- “How will people find me?”
- Play new games before others, games that have few to no videos on them, follow the hype of bigger YouTubers.
- Following other might make you seem to be a wannabe by others but that doesn’t mean you are.
- Haters are common on YouTube so if someone says something really bad...ignore them and DON’T let it get to you. That’s why trolls exist. There are people who will be blunt so they are different than trolls...they may not seem like it at first, though.

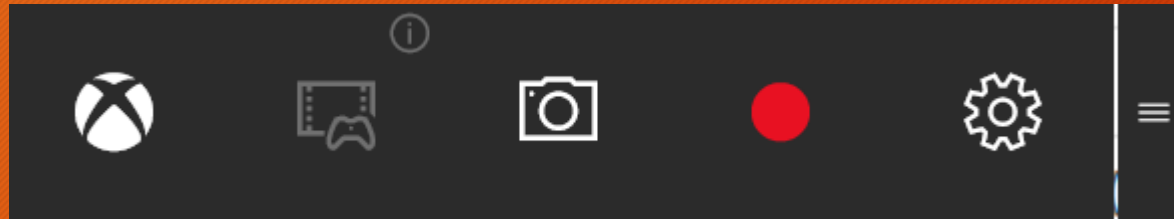

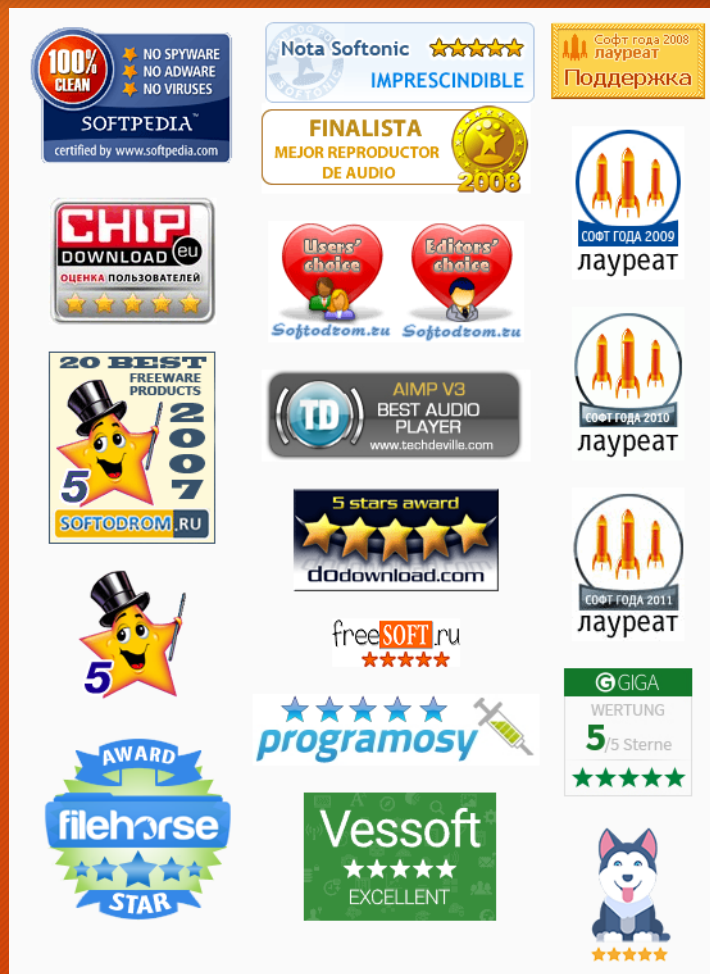

# Types of Editing

27

Once the province of expensive machines called video editors, video editing software is now available for personal computers and workstations. Video editing includes cutting segments (trimming), re-sequencing clips, and adding transitions and other Special Effects.[1]

Linear video editing, using video tape and is edited in a very linear way. Several video clips from different tapes are recorded to one single tape in the order that they will appear.

Non-linear editing system (NLE), This is edited on computers with specialised software. These are non destructive to the video being edited and use programs such as Adobe Premiere Pro, Final Cut Pro and Avid.

Offline editing is the process in which raw footage is copied from an original source, without affecting the original film stock or video tape. Once the editing has been completely edited, the original media is then re-assembled in the online editing stage.

Online editing is the process of reassembling the edit to full resolution video after an offline edit has been performed and is done in the final stage of a video production.

Vision mixing, when working within live television and video production environments. A vision mixer is used to cut live feed coming from several cameras in real time.
